This past weekend, Chess4Solidarity conducted a virtual international tournament between Israeli and Moroccan participants. The event featured 250 participants alongside a live feed and commentary. Israeli Avital Borchovsky won first prize in the tournament. The "Queen's Gambit" award, an award for the most outstanding women in the competition – named after the new Netflix show – went to Israeli Marcel Afroimsky. So far, the Chess4Solidarity initiative has hosted over 3,000 participants in solidarity events between Israel, Syria, Sudan, Algeria, Tunisia, Jordan, Egypt and more. "Israel is striving for peace with many Muslim countries, peace that will include friendly relationships and collaborations between organizations and people in many fields,' said Founder of Chess4Solidarity Lior Alzenberg.
