- 6. Chess should be in Commonwealth Games. All Federations should write to their National Olympic Committees, asking for inclusion as a medal sport.
- 7. Commonwealth Chess Association website. Best suggestion seems to be to host it on the All India Chess Federation website. It was also requested that member Associations should pay the annual affiliation fee USD 50.
