

CHANGES TO THE RATING REGULATIONS B.02

6.1 If an unrated player scores zero or half in **his first** event, his score and that of his opponents against him are disregarded. (GA 2003)

9.14c If based on results obtained in the Olympiad, a Continental Team Championship or World Team Championship, a minimum of 7 games.

9.14d If a player is a member of the IBCA, ICSC or IPCA, a minimum of 7 games.

10.31 Where a player's first result is less than 1601, or the FIDE Rating floor at the time of the event, the result(s) is ignored.

10.32 Only $R_n \geq 1601$, or the FIDE Rating floor at the time of the event, are considered.

10.52 delete

These are principally just clarifications. 9.14d has been in the regulations for some time, but never appeared in its correct place.

9.14c is new. It makes it easier to get a FIDE Rating in certain important events.
