

TRAINING MATTERS

1. There will be 5 levels of trainers :-
 - 1.1 Candidate Instructor
 - 1.2 Senior Instructor
 - 1.3 FIDE Instructor
 - 1.4 FIDE Trainer
 - 1.5 FIDE Senior Trainer

LEVEL	TITLE	QUALIFICATION	SCOPE
1	Developmental Instructor – DI	Knows the rules of Chess; rating of minimum 1600	Simple instructions
2	National Instructor – NI	Minimum 2 years experience as Developmental Instructor; rating of minimum 1800; trainees have minimum top 10 placings in recognized national-level competitions	Train players with rating up to 1800
3	FIDE Instructor - FI	Minimum 2 years experience as National Instructor; rating of minimum 2000; trainees have minimum top 3 placings in national competitions.	National examiner and conduct courses for Instructors from Levels 1 and 2; train players with rating up 2000
4	FIDE Trainer - FT	Minimum 3 years experience as FIDE Instructor; tertiary education; rating of minimum 2200; trainees have regional successes.	National examiner and conduct course for Instructors from Levels 1 to 3; train players with rating above 2100
5	International Trainer - IT	Minimum 5 years experience as FIDE Trainer; tertiary education; rating of minimum 2400; speaks English; trainees have world/international successes.	National examiner; conduct courses for chess trainers from Level 3 upwards; train players with rating above 2350

2. Temporary exception (valid until year 2010)

Trainers who have undergone and passed training courses in Russia prior to 2004 may be awarded the title of International Instructor upwards, depending on the successes of their trainees.

From 2004 onwards, Trainers who take and pass any course conducted by FIDE shall be awarded their respective titles.

3. Fees (SFr) are paid annually and a certificate and badge shall be issued.

4. Administrative Support

A special unit from the FIDE Secretariat or FIDE Academy shall need to be set up. 20% of licensed fees shall be used to defray admin expenses; FIDE shall provide the balance if necessary. A further 20% shall be assigned for international seminars/course. The balance of 60% shall be given out as bonus incentives for outstanding performances of trainers.

5. Bonus Incentives for Trainers

As an incentive for Trainers to compete among themselves to produce high-level results; bonus incentives will be given from year 2008. Only trainers who remain licensed for a consecutive period of 3 years may qualify for these rewards. The list appended is not exhaustive. Prior to the commencement of the competition, a player has to submit his nomination of trainer (up to maximum 2 names may share the reward).
