MINUTES

1. Chairman of the Committee briefed the members about the results of the Trainers' Committee discussion and voting results on Internet.
2. There was a discussion on the main issues of the Trainers' Committee reform. Deputy President G. Makropoulos started the discussion and Messrs. I. Leong, Z. Azmaiparashvili, I. Gelfer, A-N. Yazici and the others participated in it. Following the discussion, changes in the voting results were approved.
3. The Committee approved as a candidate for FIDE Trainer title Honorary Trainer of Georgia Giorgi Khomeriki. GM Artur Yussupov (GER) and GM Efstratios Grivas (GRE) were approved as candidates for FIDE Senior Trainer title.
4. The Committee approved the list of candidates for FIDE Trainers titles and recommends the list for the approval of the FIDE Executive Board. The Committee recommends awarding all candidates who pass the FIDE Trainers' Academies Seminars, with a title and a license for a term of 4 years with the subsequent training at the Seminar in order to confirm their license. The candidates who possess the recommendation of the respective National Federations will receive the title and the license for a term of 2 years, with a subsequent training at the Seminar in order to confirm their license.
5. The Committee approved a proposal of GM Uwe Boensch to create a comprehensive database of all candidates whose Trainer titles were approved by FIDE.
6. There was a discussion on the manuals and programmes for trainers. The Committee is planning to prepare the 1st volume by the next FIDE Congress in Turin, 2006. The Committee proposes the following list of the co-authors for this manual: GM Z. Azmaiparashvili, GM Y. Razuvaev, GM U. Boensch, GM A. Michalchishin, GM Y. Dorfman, GM A. Petrossian. This manual will include 25 lessons and will have 250 pages. The lessons will have detailed recommendations for the trainers how to present materials for their students. The manual will be meant for the FIDE Instructors level.
7. The Trainers Council have considered and approved the Opening of the FIDE Trainers Academy in Batumi, Georgia. The business plan and all necessary financial documents are proposed to be considered at the next Presidential Board in San Luis, Argentina.
