AMERICA REPORT

Since the General Assembly held at Calvia the activity has been concentrated in technical matters and in the fulfilling of our calendar.

Arbiter Seminars were given in Guatemala, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Panama and Aruba, and also during the Carlos Torre Memorial in Merida, Mexico.

Training Seminars were given at Guatemala, El Salvador, Nicaragua and Ecuador, this last one also in order to prepare the technical personal for the Zonals that shall be held there.

An International Training Centre was opened at Villahermosa, Mexico, under an agreement with the province authorities, to attend CACDEC Spanish speaking federations, mainly the Central America ones.

I visited Trinidad where a meeting with the Presidents of the Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago federations and also with Mr. Allan Herbert, CACDEC Co-Chairmen, was held in order to establish a Training Centre for the English speaking Caribbean federations.

During this period we supported players from Costa Rica and El Salvador to assist to chess tournaments and helped El Salvador in some computers repairs. We also supported the assistance of several Barbados players to a training seminar held at Port of Spain.

Players from Trinidad, Jamaica and Surinam are being supported to assist to the Central America and Caribbean Juniors/Girls

I assisted to the opening of a training course in Costa Rica and attended the Central America Confederation meeting being held at San Jose, July 2007

Chess material have been sent to Netherland Antilles, Jamaica and Aruba under our programs.

I want to thank both CACDEC Co-Chairmen and also FIDE Treasurer for the help and support given.

I visited Brazil and met the President of CBX where we speak in a friendly way about future events and also about the Brazil debt towards FIDE, later I went to Florianopolis where the Panamerican youth Festival shall be organized finding a very good conditions for the event.

Concerning the arrears some America Federations have I have help FIDE Treasurer and have spoken with them over the need to solve this problem.
