FIDE Asian Events Calendar 2005 (Annex 1)

Because of the Tsunami Asian Men Individual Chess Championship Scheduled In Cochin India During January 13-23 2005 Was Postponed. New dates were announced as 21-31 March 2005 in the same place it was again postponed due to interim injunction against the AICF Hon Secretary PT Ummer Koya to interfere in any manner and in any capacity in the affairs of AICF. The President of AICF Mr. Srinivasan Appointed Mr. DV SUNDAR as the New Hon Secretary of the AICF until the next elections in October. Three other followers of Mr Koya Namely Mr. Harsh Mr. Bhaskaran and Mr. Bobba announced themselves as President Secretary and treasurer claiming that they removed the president and the Secretary from office for which another order made by the court this time against Mr. Koya and Mr. Harsh , Bhaskaran, Bobba to not interfere in the AICF affairs in any manner.

As I reported earlier the legitimate office bearers are Mr. Srinivasan as President and Dv Sundar as Hon Secretary, They attended the FIDE Presidential Board in Doha May 2005 and Reported in every detail with all the necessary documents. Presidential Board Recognized the New office bearers as the Legitimate Federation in India.

The New office bearers are ready to Organize the Asian Individual Chess Championship during the Period 5 – 16 October in Hyderabad.

They are also ready to organize Asian youth under-8,10,12&14 15th – 23rd Nov 05 New Delhi Other Events are in the.
