The number of places a Continent receives depends on how the national teams are ranked in the Olympiad preceding the Continental/Zonal Championships. This encourages teams to continue to be ranked within the specified spots.

The second of the World Junior (Girls) Championships have to be held before the World Cup and Women's World Championship. Thus the World Junior has the same importance every year instead of only during the year of the WC/WWC.
