Change of the Regulations for the World Chess Team Championship

Article 8.6: Scoring

The article changes into following:

8.6 Scoring

Each team's place in the order of classification will be decided by the number of the **sum of match points (won match = 2 points, drawn match = 1 point)** it has scored.

8.6.1 If any teams finish with equal match points, the tie shall be resolved according to the following tie break criteria:

- (a). by the **sum of game points each tem scored.**
- (b). by the **sum of match points by the tying teams against each other.**
- (c). by the **sum of game points by the tying teams against each other.**
- (d). by the **Berlin System (board- count)** as follows :

a win on Board 1	4 points
a win on Board 1	3 points
a win on Board 1	2 points
a win on Board 1	1 points

In case of drawn games these points are shared.

If the board-count results in no victory for either side then the board points of Board 4 are cancelled and so on upwards until the tie is broken.

(e). if a tie still results between teams in contention for medals, these teams shall play **a match against each other at a fast time-rate** (15 minutes per player for the entire game). A drawing of lots shall be for the colors.

- (f). if this match is indecisive, **lots shall be drawn.**
