6. Miscellaneous

6.1. Arrangement of the World Chess Olympiad in Riga in 2010.
(E.Šneps, A.Vrubļevskis, I.Druviete, Ā.Ozoliņš, E.Berķis, G.Bērziņš)

6.1. Mr. Ā.Ozoliņš and Mr. E.Berķis hereby inform of the opportunity for Latvia to register as candidate for taking part in the arrangement of the World Chess Olympiad of the year 2010. Possible number of participants is 1500 from 160 countries. The term of registration is set 26 February 2006. To propose as candidate for taking part in the arrangement of the World Chess Olympiad of 2010 it is required to make security deposit to the amount of CHF 10000. Total amount of the security deposit for arranging the World Chess Olympiad of 2010 might be CHF 1000000. Total amount of the necessary costs for arranging the World Chess Olympiad of 2010 might achieve USD 4000000. Mrs.I.Druviete specifies that the organization of such an event in Latvia will be supported in principle.

Mr. G.Bērziņš specifies that for arranging such grand scale event it is necessary to accumulate due experience first arranging less scale event, as well as the financial resources required for organizing this event are too large and at present nobody is able to undertake and promise any financial backing without knowing further state budget opportunities and priorities.

Mr.E. Berķis explains that the Latvian Chess Association has arranged a series of great international events including participation of any grand chess-master, for example, G.Kasparov. Mr. A.Vrubļevskis points out that the idea and the event are morally supported but without the direct financing on the part of the state.

The National Sport Council has resolved:

6.1.1 To take into consideration the information received. To support the Latvian Chess Association aimed at the application for taking part in the arrangement of the World Chess Olympiad of 2010. To resolve regarding the state financial contribution at the next meeting of the National Sport Council.


