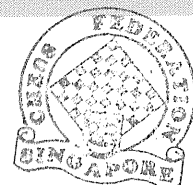



In accordance with FIDE regulations, the entry fee payable to FIDE is 40 EUR per player. Their National Federation must send this amount directly to FIDE. For participants who registered through their School, the FIDE entry fee must be paid before the start of the first round either to their National Federation (proof of a Receipt/document) or to the Organising Committee in Singapore.
