2011 WORLD YOUTH TRAVEL GRANT

The primary aim of this programme is to encourage greater participation by CACDEC Federations in the Continental Youth Events by rewarding the top performers with assistance towards attending World Youth.

The selection criterion for the winning candidate in each age group is the highest placed player from a CACDEC Federation ranked in the top 10 or the top 20% of the final standings. Based on the above criteria the following 17 players are 2011 World Youth Travel Grant Winners:

The World Youth Grant must be used in the same year it was won for the World Youth of that year and is provided for the player not the Federation, i.e. the Federation cannot substituted the player with another player from the Federation.

For 2011, I would like to propose that the grant be US\$1,000 per player.

Obviously, we would like to encourage the Federation of grant winners to use this opportunity to generate good press for the players and the Federation in their local press by arranging press conferences to announce the award.

We would also like to ask each Continent to publish a formal announcement of these awards on their Web Site. To facilitate this, the Federation should send a photo and brief bio of their grant winners to the General Secretary of the Development Commission by October 30th 2011.
