## ARBITER'S REPORT

# The 2010 World Women's Blitz Championship Moscow, September 14-18, 2010

### 1. Event, participants and results

The 2010 World Women's Blitz Championship was an event with preliminary tournament and the double round-robin final. Preliminaries:

- Continental On-Line Open Qualification Tournaments (Europe, America, Asia and Africa), 1-10 June 2010, [www.playchess.com](http://www.playchess.com)
- Quarterfinal with 26 participants (9 rounds), Moscow, 14 September 2010
- Semifinal with 34 participants – 13 double rounds Swiss event, Moscow, 15-16 September 2010
- Final with 16 participants – double Round Robin event (30 rounds), Moscow, 17-18 September 2010

2. The Prize fund for the Final is 50 000 Euro (I - 10 000 Euro, XVI – 500 Euro)
