Subject: suspension proposal of Turkish Chess Federation

Dear Mr.Freeman,

On behalf of Turkish Chess Federation we make following proposal to FIDE General Assembly in Istanbul.

#### Proposal

If any FIDE rated player is given a suspension by his/her national federation and that suspension finalised in all possible courts in the country it happened, then FIDE will respect the national federation and courts to apply same suspension for the same period for any FIDE rated event including private events. This player during that suspension executed may not participate with any title to any FIDE event or ceremony or meeting. The National chess federation, will send a written notice with all legal procedures translated to English to FIDE, after the final decision is taken according to National Laws in the related country. This notice must be written and follow the final legal decision of respected court in the respected country. The notice should be during suspension, if national federation does not send the notice during suspension, then FIDE is not responsible for players participation to any event. When FIDE gets notice and if it is a legal notice under this rule, then FIDE will hang players rating till suspension time finishes in maximum 10 days. This rule comes to power just after being accepted by General Assembly.

We will be happy if you confirm that you got this e-mail on 7th June 2012 and will carry it to agenda of General Assembly.
