GM Luis Gallego, who won the Portuguese championship in 2012, has been accused to have taken a forbidden substance. The Portuguese Chess Federation has stripped him of the title. The Portuguese Chess Federation asks what to do with the tournament.

The Portuguese Chess Federation sees two options:

1. Update the classification, so the 2nd becomes 1st, the 3rd becomes 2nd and so on;
2. All the games played by GM Luis Gallego are not valid and update the classification.
