FIDE PB 2/2015 (Abu Dhabi - UAE * 01-09.09.2015)

REPORT - June 20th, 2015

Dear Mr. President,

Here is our Commission's Report for the FIDE EB/PB 2/2015. We have held our Meeting of this period via Internet (20.06.2015). We have noted all proposals and decisions concerning the operation of our Commission and we have informed the Executive Director and we were able to solve in perfect harmony all subjects. Most of the **TRG Minutes** contents concerns formalities and general every-day work, but there are some issues which should be exclusively decided by the PB. From these extensive **Minutes** we ask you to approve the following:

1. New TRG Titles: TRG Council voted on applications and confirmed seminar results according to the TRG Regulations and approved the attached titles (Annex: TRG-01-New Titles).

2. TRG Academies: The Council examined Academies' applications as follows:

2.1. By the 'FLRC Advance Institute of Chess Excellence' (Chennai - India * Annexes: TRG-02-FIDE Academy Application - India 01-26). The Council rejected the application, as under the present circumstances the Academy Application cannot be accepted.

2.2. By the 'African Chess Lounge' (Cape Town - South Africa * Annex: TRG-02-FIDE Academy Application - South Africa 5). The Council endorses the application.

2.3. By the 'Logic NI' (Belfast - Ireland * Annexes: TRG-02-FIDE Academy Application - Ireland 1 & 2). The Application doesn't contain the required signatures but all approval can be found in the e-mail. Therefore, the Council endorses the application.

2.4. By the 'Cairo Chess Academy' Cairo - Egypt * Appendix: TRG-02-Application Academy-Egypt 1 & 2). This Application is still pending from the previous PB.

3. FIDE/TRG Awards 2014: The Council approved the Voting & the Results of the 2014 FIDE/TRG Awards (Annex: TRG-03-FIDE Trainer Awards 2014-Results).

4. Problems between FIDE Commissions' Regulations: The Council was informed on the various problems between FIDE Commissions' Regulations and the main problem of unification and approved the relative letter (Annex: TRG-04-TRG Regulations-Problems). The Council wishes to note that it is not quite happy with the previous PB decisions on the subject and wishes to be re-examined.

Dear Mr. Nigel Freeman, FIDE Executive Director

Greetings from Egyptian chess federation, ECF.

I read that FIDE PB at Chengdu may approve some chess academies including proposed Cairo Chess Academy, which is managed by IA Mohamed Farouk Fahim of Egypt. So that I'd like to inform you that ECF is against the approval of that academy for the following reasons:

1- According to statutes of Egyptian Ministry of Youth & Sports, the ECF is the only authorized body to supervise any chess activity inside Egypt. So ECF should grant a primary approval for such academy before FIDE may recognize it.

2- The manager of Cairo Chess Academy, Mr. Mohamed Farouk didn't follow the procedures to get initial approval from ECF for his academy. He didn't submit the form and didn't deliver a proof of rent contract of the venue of his academy. He didn't pay the amount of Euro 360, the fees for his IA, FI titles and attendance fees of an internet seminar for organizers and these fees are indicated in the last invoice of ECF to be paid to FIDE and if he doesn't pay these fees, so ECF will not pay on his behalf to FIDE.

3- As you can see down in this email: a message sent from Mr. Grivas to Mr. Mohamed Farouk, asking him to follow the procedures in order to get approval for his academy, BUT he didn't yet!

I hope that FIDE may not approve this academy until its manager follow the procedures and pay his arrears to ECF or directly to FIDE and respect other procedures.

Subject: TRG Regulations

Dear Chairmen & Secretaries,

We would like to draw your attention to Articles 4.1 & 4.2 of the TRG Regulations (attached) and the problems that we do face, as Organizers & Arbiters 'refuse' to implement them. Recently we had another negative case in the World School Championships 2015 (Pattaya, Thailand, 06-15.05.2015 – Organiser Ignatius Leong – Chief Arbiter Mahdi Abdulrahim).

The Trainers' Commission is under attack from some of its members (certified & licenced trainers) as (for example) can be observed here: <http://worldschoolsches.com/ivan-sokolov-the-hotel-and-playing-conditions-are-fine-here/> *'One thing is very pity that I, as a FIDE licenced trainer, cannot enter the hall to follow the games. But I understand maybe organizers have their own ideas why they don't allow us to be there. But I find it a pity, for I think there are not so many of us here at this tournament. For instance in the Olympiads, If I, as a trainer, am allowed to enter the area and be 1.5 meters from the game Kramnik-Anand, I don't see why I can't watch a game of 13-14 years old players here. But as I said, maybe organizers have their own ideas.'*

When these articles were approved back in 2011 it was clear that all licenced trainers (and only them and surely not parents as were seen in the above mentioned event!) would have full access to the playing hall, in all FIDE events. Now suddenly we have disputes between trainers, arbiters & organizers, which shouldn't be the case between Commissions of the same body and for approved Regulations.

We would kindly ask you to adjust your Commissions' Regulations in accordance with the attached (Articles 4.1 & 4.2), which are approved by the FIDE General Assembly and inform your members for further procedures.

If you have any objections or you would like any changes, we can discuss them in the coming FIDE Congress. But until then we again kindly ask you to assist our efforts.
