Chief Arbiter's Report

FIDE World Schools Individual Championship Pattaya, Thailand 06-15 May 2015

- The FIDE World Schools Individual Chess Championship was organized in Pattaya City, Thailand from 6 to 15 May 2015, by the ASEAN Chess Academy, FIDE, and the Thailand Chess Association.
- The Championships were governed by the General Regulations for FIDE Competitions and these Rules.
- Everything was good. The events were very well organized. The technical team was working together with the rest of the tournament staff to serve the participants the best as we can.
- There were six categories Under 7, U9, U11, U13, U15, and U17 with separate events for Open & Girls.
- The World Blitz Schools Individual Championship was held in the same place, in 11th May 2015 for Open and Girls.
- A Social Night was organized on 10th May 2015.

Technical Meeting:

- The technical meeting was held in the same tournament hall. The chief organizer, FIDE technical delegate, the tournament director, and I attended with the players & Federation representative and we discussed some details of the regulations.
- The draw for colors was made during the Technical meeting for all categories and separate events for Open and Girls.
- The youngest Boy under category 7 chose the color Black for the both Open and Girls events.
- The events were both Swiss system tournaments and were held over seven days for the Standard and one day for the Blitz.
- The Standard events were played with nine (9) rounds Swiss, with five days of single rounds and two days double rounds. The Blitz events were with seven (7) rounds Swiss in one day.
- There was an Arbiters' meeting before the start of the first round.

Opening Ceremony:

- On May 7th the opening Ceremony was held in the Dusit Thani Hotel in Pattaya City. It was a short Opening Ceremony and all participants took part. The anthem of Thailand and the FIDE anthem were played to start the Opening Ceremony.
- Mr. Philip Chan, Director of the Social activities conducted the ceremony. He greeted all the participants of the championships, parents, guests and officials of this event.
- The Chief Organizer IA/IO Mr. Ignatius Leong, President of the ASEAN Chess Academy, tournament director Mr. Panupand Vijjuprabba, General Secretary of the Thailand Chess Federation, the President of the International School Chess Union Alexander Kostyev, and the official FIDE Technical Delegate Mr. Zgur Solakoglu delivered their welcome address to all the participants, guests, organizers and partners in Thailand.
- Also, the floor was given to a special guest of the Opening Ceremony Mr. Banjong Bantoon Prayub, the Deputy Spokesman of Pattaya City. On behalf of Pattaya government he welcomed the participants and guests of the championships.
- To uphold the spirit of sportsmanship and fair play in the championship, and to uphold the spirit and integrity of the laws of chess, the oath was given on behalf of the all Players & the Arbiters.

The Playing Hall:

- The playing hall and its environs met the requirements of the FIDE Regulations for the Organization of these Tournaments. It was well prepared and equipped.
- The audience, parents and delegations watched the Top Board games for each category from the screens displayed outside the tournament in a neighboring hall. Games were displayed as well through the official and various websites.
- The playing venue was decorated with the FIDE flag, the flags of the Thailand and the participating players' Federations and also for the sponsors' brandings.
- Only photographers and camera crews expressly authorized by the Organizing Committee worked in the playing venue. Flash was used only during the first ten minutes.
- Organizers provided, free of charge, coffee and tea, for the arbiters.
- The games were played using DGT's clocks for all boards and electronic boards of the top game in each category.
- The President of Thailand Chess Association Mr. Kittiratt NA-RANONG was present in the tournament hall.
- IA Mr. Ozgur Solakoglu was the FIDE Technical Delegate.
- IA/IO Mr. Ignatius Leong was the Chief Organizer.
- IA Mr. Panupand VIJJUPRABHA was the Tournament Director.
- The webmaster was IA Long Peter from Malaysia, and the top game for each category was published online via the official website and others by FA Hoang Thien from Vietnam.

Time Control

1. FIDE World Schools Individual Championship:

Each player had 90 minutes for 40 moves and 30 minutes for the rest of the game with the addition of 30 seconds per move starting from the first move.

2. World Blitz Schools Individual Championship:

Each player had only 5 minutes to finish the game without any increment.

Tie Break:

- The tie break system for medals and ranking was as follows:
 1. Direct Encounter.
 2. Buchholz Cut 1.
 3. Buchholz.
 4. Greater number of Wins with Black Pieces.
 5. Greater number of Wins.

- The players cooperated reasonably with the media. They had short interviews with section player from each category after each game.

- The Secretary of the Thailand Chess Association, Tournament Director IA Mr. Panupand Vijjeprabha was then invited to the stage. He addressed staff, arbiters, distinguished guests, participants, parents.
- The organizers with the FIDE official crowned the winners of the FIDE world Schools champions 2015.
