#### **❖ INVITATION**

Chess Association of "West Azarbaijan" province on behalf of I.R. Iran Chess Federation is pleased to invite all players from national federations to participate in the 4<sup>th</sup> Sardaran International Open Chess Tournaments from 22-29 July 2015 in Urmia, Iran.



### 1. Rules and Regulations

- The tournaments will be played according to the **Swiss System of 9 rounds**.
- o The tournaments are open to all local chess players and foreign players whohave FIDE ID
- o All Participants accept to fully comply with the rules and regulations of I.R. Iran
- o If a player qualifies for more than one prize, he/she will be given the prize with a higher value
- o If two or more players share the same place in Table A, the "Cash Prize" will be shared by Hort system.
- o All players must be present at the closing ceremony to receive financial prizes. The organizers reserve the rights not to pay out prizes if the participant fails to do so
- o The organizer can include a limited number of players with lower Elo in the Master tournament.
- o The tournament will be rated with FIDE and is valid for FIDE title norms

# 2 .Reception and Playing Venue

Tournament will take place at Morvarid Hotel.

# ❖ 3.Tournament System

- 2.1 Tournaments are organized according to FIDE Rules.
- 2.2 Definition of Tournaments is:
  - a. Table A for Players with Rating +2100
  - b. Table B for Players with Rating 2100
  - c. Table C for Youths under 14 years Old (Boys & Girls)
  - d. Table D for Women Chess Players (Maral Cup)
  - e. Table E. Blitz (2\*3+2)

#### 4.TimeControl

**90 minutes** for the entire game with an increment of **30 seconds** per move starting from the move 1.



## 5.Tie Break System

#### o Table A

- Direct Encounter (if tied players have all played each other)
- Rating Average of opponents without lowest and highest Opponent
- Greater number of victories
- Most games as black
- Buchholz

### Table B, C, D & E

- Buchholz Cut 1
- Buchholz Cut 2
- Median Buchholz 1
- Median Buchholz 2
- Sum of the Buchholz

### 6. Pairings and Procedure of Appeals

Pairings will be made using Swiss Manager Software and shall be announced as soon as possible after each round finishes. Pairings will be published on the www.chess-results.com.

Protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter or any other Arbiter must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the Appeals committee within one hour after completion of the playing session. The protest must be accompanied with the sum of 3000000 Rials (Iran Rial Currency) or 100 USD ,as a deposit from the signatory. If the protest is accepted and the decision changed, then the deposit will be returned back to the claimant.

### 9. Blitz Rated Tournament

The rated blitz tournament starts on 26<sup>th</sup> July at 10:30 in Morvarid hotel. The tournament format is 11-round or 13-round Swiss, computer pairings. The tournament is FIDE rated. The time control is 3 min per player+ 2 sec.
