Chairman Mr. Boris Kutin welcomed all the attendees and gave brief information about the Commissions' activities.

1. Secretary Mr. Theodoros Tsorbatzoglou informed that the Commission meeting would last from 15.00 to 19.00 but was expected to finish earlier. He reported about the activities of the Commission and the recent World Chess Championships monitored by the EVE Commission.
2. Senior Director Mr. Dirk Jordan presented an extensive report about the evaluation of the World Seniors Championships by inspectors and later by the FIDE Technical Delegates. The report was accepted. Next step is to implement this report and its positive proposals to the evaluation criteria used by the FIDE inspectors.
3. The General Regulations from the Rules Commission were presented. The EVE Commission will wait for the work of the Commission established by FIDE Central Board of Commission about the areas of the responsibility in Handbook and will take position about the EVE responsibility and its part of regulations.
4. it was decided from the year 2021 the minimum prize fund of the World Amateur Chess Championship to be raised to 15,000 euros.
5. It was discussed the request from Chinese Chess Association to move the World Cadets Chess Championship dates in July 2019. The Chairman Boris Kutin authorized to make the necessary contacts with the Continents not to clash with their respective programs.
6. It was reported from the appointed Inspector Mr. Ozgur Solakoglou that he tried to make the inspection for the World Cadets Chess Championship 2020 in Italy but this was not possible due to problems of the organisers. FIDE General Assembly to decide for the venues 2020.

7. After the proposal of the Belarus Chess Federation the Commission decided to establish the special Award “Viktor Kupreichik” for the best game in the annual World Seniors Championships. Belarus Chess Federation will provide to FIDE the awards.

8. Commission Chairman Boris Kutin thanked all Commission's members for their work and all the attendees for the wide participation and the contribution in the Commission meetings.
