The Brazilian Chess Federation proposes the creation of the “Chess Commission for Social Projects”.

The chess practice extrapolates the sporting environment and provides for individuals of any gender, sex and age, a reflection of moral and ethical values, the stimulation of cognitive skills, improvement of psychological and social opportunities

The insertion of chess as a strategy for social inclusion is a reality in Brazil and some parts of the world, occurring mostly in local projects and as ad hoc manner. This strategy is used in educational projects in environments such as prisons, assisted children and children assisted in socio-educational measures, monitoring of chemical dependents, stimulation of the 3rd age people and individuals with special needs.

The proposal of the creation of the Chess Commission for Social Projects at the FIDE is justified to promote actions, guidelines and standards of this growing application of chess.
