Agenda for the meeting of Swiss Pairings Program committee:

- Amendmant to the Dutch Swiss Rules C6
 Old wording: if now p pairings are obtained in compliance with B1 and B2
 New wording: if now p pairings are obtained in compliance with B1 until B6
 The old wording is simply not correct. The new wording is describing what all arbiters are doing now.
- 2. Amendment to the Dutch Swiss Rules B6 Note:

Old wording: Ignore B2, B5 and B6 when pairing players with a score of over 50 %

New wording: Ignore B2 (first B2a than B2b) when pairing players with a score of over $50 \% \dots$

The rules B5 and B6 are already ignored when pairing procedure has passed C9 and C10 before arriving at this decision point. Therefore this change will be just a correction of wording.

Up to now there is no rule what to do if there is a choice whether to skip B2a or B2b. The conclusion may be: First B2b than B2a. But this question must be decided.
